Greetings,

The month of February has been very busy for the Post and March promises to be the same.

We had several guests at our meeting this month. The Girl Scouts for "Operation Cookie Drop", Former County Commissioner Kiesling for the Alexander Memorial Statue, Veterans Memorial Video about a video project.

The most pressing requests were little league team sponsorship at Danny Smith Park and Operation Cookie Drop. We decided to continue our team sponsorship (cost \$400) and committed \$200 to the Girl Scouts (the Auxiliary also gave \$100).

The repair of the Alexander Memorial is a hugely expensive undertaking. The need is for \$5000 of seed money to start the process. The total cost of repairs could be as much as \$200,000. The committee is looking for large (\$1,000-2,000) donations from all the veterans groups. Because of this, we tabled the discussion until the March 20th. I feel, as 20th and 21st century veterans, it is our duty to continue to memorialize our Civil War veterans. Their sacrifice 150 years ago gave us the freedom loving country that made our lives so wonderful. Please consider the donation we are being ask for. If we do make this level of support, it may preclude some of our traditional charity giving and also prevent other giving for the next year.

The house committee, after long research, made the recommendation that we buy an automatic fryer and a indoor gas grill/charbroiler. Although this is a major
