## **Recent History - Rebirth of VFW Post 604**

How quickly 10 years have passed. At this time in 2008, VFW Post 604 had already faced the reality that declining membership and reduced participation meant we could no longer financially support operations in downtown Bloomington and we were in the process of closing our doors at 209 S College Avenue – our future relatively uncertain.

Leadership in VFW Department of Indiana and District 7 expressed great concern that Post 604 was in jeopardy of closing forever. This was a legitimate worry, but our members were committed to proving this anxiety unnecessary.

In May 2009, Post 604 purchased our new post home at 2404 W Industrial Park Drive, but this was just the beginning of our renaissance. Next came the rip-out of existing building infrastructure and remodeling to meet our perceived business needs; a bar area, a dining room, a kitchen, offices, etc. This work was done mostly by volunteers and lasted nearly 22 months. The word <u>V O L U N T E E R S</u> is an important part of that last sentence, as it has become a concept we now live by.

Since our grand reopening in July 2011, we have operated completely with unpaid volunteers. This is quite an achievement and is the envy of many VFW posts in the state. It hasn't always been an easy road as the number of volunteers tend to fluctuate, but we have been successful. We have also created an atmosphere of cooperation and camaraderie.

Over the last 10 years our monthly expenses average \$6,330 per month with the following approximate distribution by percentage:


